## SDRC is a Non-Profit Organization

We hear about non-profit organizations, but what determines this status and why does San Diego Reiki Corps qualify? SDRC is classified as a 501C(3) non-profit organization. Our platform, according to our By-Laws, is to benefit the public and continue to further the education of our members. A non-profit typically makes a profit in order to support the operation of the organization, and ultimately is a facilitator for helping and educating the community.



To accomplish our goals, SDRC engages in several different types of activities: it holds monthly Reiki Shares for Practitioners, both members and non-members; it provides Reiki service to hospitals and hospices; and throughout the year Community Outreach Projects are held in partnership with such organizations as Veteran's Stand Down, American Cancer Society, SD Homeless Project, the Humane Society and many others. The SDRC also organizes educational and social workshops for members and the general public. The Board meets regularly to oversee the operations.

As a 501C(3), SDRC is exempt from paying taxes and can receive donations and hold fundraising events to further its goals. This allows donors to potentially claim contributions on their taxes.
