
### "Trauma Informed Care"

"Trauma Informed Care" is a broad term covering treatment frameworks that involve recognizing, understanding, and responding to the effects of all types of trauma. Louise plans to discuss PTSD, ACES, and Moral Injury, and to share valuable information and techniques for helping clients with these traumas. Whether you are highly intuitive or not, as Reiki practitioners it is crucial to be aware of and sensitive to how trauma impacts people, on many different levels. Trauma memories can be released in surprising ways, both by our clients and by ourselves.

#### Story #2, 10-2-17

In July, a cousin visited San Diego for a conference and we spent a day together. Before her visit we had been communicating for months about her anxiety. Her career in New York is high stress in a financial environment. I had shared the possibility of Reiki being useful to decrease her anxiety level, and during our time together, I attuned her to Reiki I.
