## Story #3, 12-21-17

A friend of mine took me to San Diego Botanical Gardens in Encinitas for my birthday. I claim not to be a joiner, but I quickly did the math and purchased a 12 month membership. The newsletter arrived monthly.

The following summer I noticed a Meditation Series with Crystal Bowls in the newsletter. Being more than a "little tightly wound," I recruited two office mates – one "more tightly wound" than me and one with a "spiritual" practice. We attended a class. At the end of the class, the "more tightly wound" companion seemed as if she had been awakened from a deep (possibly drugged) sleep. The "spiritual" companion seemed relaxed and at peace. I, the "little tightly wound" person in the group, felt rested. I had a lot of questions. I approached the sisters that guided the meditation class. Of course, they were trying to go home but were very patient with me. It seems they had a question for me. One of the sisters said "you do Reiki?" I replied "No" (and probably looked either stupefied or horrified by the question) but I am interested in being a healer. One of the sisters said that she had a monthly Reiki share primarily for her students but that I could attend if I wanted. Personally, I think extending the Reiki share invitation was the only way she could think of to extract herself from my questions and go home for the evening.

I attended the Reiki share. Everyone was welcoming and kind. Over time I noticed that more people not affiliated with Reiki were asking me if I practiced Reiki. I was perplexed as to why this question was continually being asked. More time passed and I asked myself. "What do these people see or know that I do not?" I believe that questions and opportunities are presented in life for a reason. After some time, I decided that I owed it to myself and the universe to explore the answer to the question "you do Reiki."

Once I made my decision, I pursued my teacher and Reiki training. I took Reiki 1 classes and said I'm not taking Reiki 2. I took Reiki 2 classes and said I will not be a Reiki Master. I
